Elementary 1-6 (Année Fondamentale- AF)

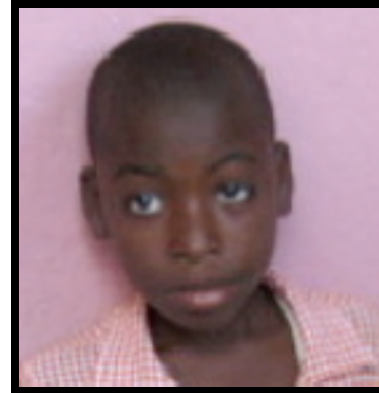
A school located in the chapel of St. Mary Magdalene in Grand Ravine, a mission from the parish of St. Bernadette of Martissant, this school has been serving over 2,000 poor and disenfranchised children for more than 12 years—focusing on their intellectual, social, and religious formation (from grades 1-6). The seven teachers are young, dynamic, and devoted to the community. The school runs with the help of a director/principal, vice principal, and secretary. The building is divided into 7 classrooms with 40 benches and an office.
